100th Anniversary of the Turtle Flambeau Flowage



The Turtle Flambeau Flowage was created in 1926 with the construction of the Turtle Flambeau Dam, which harnesses the power of the Turtle and Flambeau Rivers to generate energy. The resulting reservoir includes 14,300 acres of water, 227 miles of undeveloped shoreline, 16 natural lakes, three rivers, and several pristine creeks—all beautifully free of pollution.


HOV Economic Impact Study
